SAMPLE:

405 Adults (18+) in the InterCity Transit Service Area

TECHNIQUE:

Telephone Survey with Live Interviewers 40% via cell phone;

FIELD DATES:

June 29 – July 3, 2018

SAMPLE FRAME:

All households within the four cities in which at least one person is registered to vote (N=51,387) and for which a telephone number was available (n=16,546).

MARGIN OF ERROR:







CAUSES OF TRANSPORTATION PROBLEMS




LEVEL OF TRANSPORTATION SERVICES








PREFERRED BROAD STRATEGY



INTERCITY TRANSIT PERFORMANCE RATING




