

AMENDMENT #9

The Transit Pass Program AGREEMENT dated September 27, 2010, between INTERCITY TRANSIT and SAINT MARTIN'S UNIVERSITY (SMU) is hereby amended.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the UNIVERSITY has authorized the collection of a per credit fee for the purpose of providing bus service to all undergraduate students enrolled in credit bearing classes; and,

WHEREAS, the parties seek to continue the pass program for the remainder of 2019;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the terms, conditions, covenants, and performance contained within the original agreement as amended herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. The Transit Pass Program AGREEMENT dated September 27, 2010, between INTERCITY TRANSIT and SAINT MARTIN'S UNIVERSITY is hereby amended as follows:

a. Article 4. PASS VALID DATES is changed to reflect the following schedule for use of a valid SMU undergraduate student ID card:

- Fall session: valid from September 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019

b. Article 4. PAYMENT is changed to reflect estimated ridership and cost for Fall session 2019. Services provided under the student transit pass program shall be funded by the UNIVERSITY. TRANSIT will invoice the UNIVERSITY \$5,490.62 for services delivered in September, October, November and December 2019.

Total payment for the Fall 2019 Session shall not exceed \$5,490.62

c. Article 5. PROCEDURE FOR USE is changed to include unrestricted and unlimited student use of Express Commuter routes between Thurston County and Pierce County.

d. Article 8. REPORTS AND EVALUATIONS is changed to reflect that TRANSIT will assess student ridership three times during this Agreement – generally during the months of September, January and April.

e. Intercity Transit contract manager is: Rob LaFontaine, Planning Manager

2. All other terms and conditions of the original Agreement remain unchanged.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, TRANSIT and UNIVERSITY have caused this Amendment to be executed this 9th day of December 2019.
