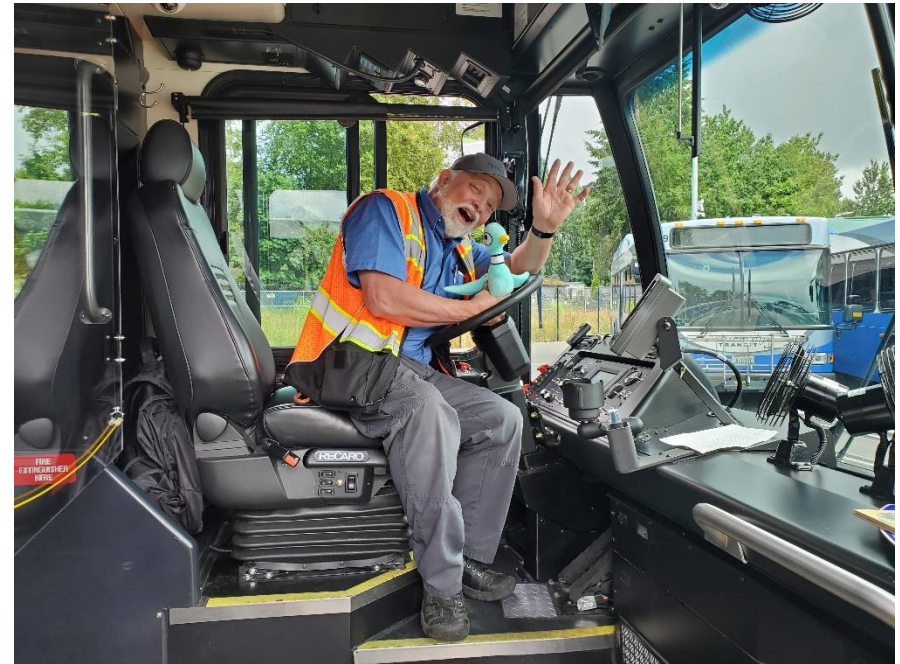
Practice looking left, right, left	Ride somewhere new	Wave to another cyclist	Make streamers for your bike	Ride in a circle to the right

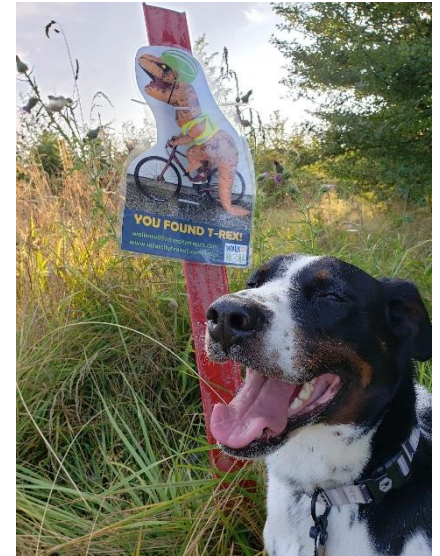

Earn-A-Bike

Remote Learning Format

- Recruit participants through social-service organization.
- Video-based online lessons. (beginning development now)
- Partner with school for bike pickup days.

Walk N Roll

Community Bike Shop

- Closed since spring.
- Large inventory of repaired bikes.
- Using shop closure as an opportunity to improve fixtures and organization.
