### Why is the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) important?

- Identify and reprioritize projects based on funding changes and project priorities
- The FTA requires us to review all potentially federally funded projects publicly
- First step in the annual cycle of reviewing and updating IT's planning documents and identifying projects that need to be programmed in the STIP.
- All projects need to be in the STIP to be obligated

# HIGH-CAPACITY CORRIDOR SERVICE OR BRT "LIGHT"

#### What is Bus Rapid Transit?

Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) is a high-frequency bus-based transit system that delivers fast, direct, comfortable, and cost-effective service.

Because BRT contains features similar to rail service. It is much faster, more reliable, and more convenient than regular bus services. With the right features, BRT avoids the causes of delays that typically slow regular bus services, like being stuck in traffic and paying on board.
