

2018 ESMS Focus Areas

Focus Areas are high priority activities, products, and services that may negatively impact the environment. We want to reduce or prevent negative impacts in these areas and our focus areas change over time.



Vehicle Performance & Fuel Use

Goal: Reduce environmental, natural resources, and financial impacts of fuel use.

Targets: Reduce our fleet's Greenhouse Gas (GHG) emissions by 0.5% in 2018. That is approximately 60 metric tons of GHG.

We will:

- Fuel 12 Dial-A-Lift vans with propane in 2018.
- Evaluate zero-emission renewable diesel (R-99) for use in coaches and Dial-A-Lift vans.



- Evaluate Voith transmissions for eight new coaches in 2020.

Underground Storage Tank Replacement

Goal: Protect stormwater quality during off-site vehicle fueling.

Target: Zero spills during off-site fueling operations.



We will:

- Report and track fuel island spills with Safety Committee's Event Report form.
- Develop and implement temporary off-site fueling procedures.
- Perform spill drills to keep staff in practice.
- Update Spill Prevention and Emergency Clean-up Plan.

New Underground Storage Tank Operations

Goal: Protect stormwater quality during vehicle fueling.

Target: Zero spills during first three months of new fuel island operation.

We will:

- Report and track fuel island spills with Safety Committee's Event Report form.



- Update fueling and bulk fluids delivery procedures.



Responding, Reporting, & Tracking Off-site Spills

Goal: Protect stormwater quality during off-site spill response.

Target: No targets set in 2018.

In 2016 we:

- Updated Operator Manual for off-site spill response.
- Trained Operators and Operations Supervisors on new off-site spill response procedures.



- Standardized off-site response and clean-up procedures with local jurisdictions.
- Reported and tracked off-site spills with Safety Committee's Event Report form. In 2018, we will continue this work.
