July Service Update: Effective July 2, 2017

Express Service

- <u>Sound Transit (ST) 592 & Intercity Transit 609:</u>
 Last day of service is June 30. With the end of grant funds, coupled with very low ridership on most trips, the routes are no longer sustainable. Please note: ST 592, Dupont/Lakewood/Seattle, remains unchanged. Contact ST for information.
- Route 612 Olympia to Tacoma:
 Grant funds from the Washington State
 Department of Transportation will help
 provide the addition of seven southbound
 and six northbound weekday trips. Early and
 late afternoon trips replace the few Route 609
 trips that had better than average ridership
 and to fill mid-day service gaps. The new trips
 will continue to serve Lacey's Hawks Prairie
 Park & Ride. Transfer connections to Route 13,
 along Capitol Way, are available for customers
 traveling to/from Tumwater.
- Route 603 Northbound Trip to Tacoma:
 The current 5:05 p.m. trip will be adjusted to leave the Olympia Transit Center at 5:15 p.m.
 A new Route 612 trip has been added at 5 p.m.
