Earn-A-Bike Serves 74 in 2017



Earn-A-Bike is an after-school program that teaches middle school students basic bicycle maintenance and skills to safely ride in their neighborhood. After students graduate from

Earn-A-Bike they earn a refurbished bicycle along with a helmet, lock, bike map, and more.

In 2017, 74 students graduated from Earn-A-Bike after receiving eight hours of bicycle and maintenance instruction.

Earn-A-Bike relies on bike shop volunteers to help refurbish donated bicycles. In 2017 the volunteers put in an impressive 1,306 hours at our bike shop and built 93 bicycles to be used during Earn-A-Bike classes.

The bike shop is located in D.G. Parrott & Son Machinist Shop in downtown Olympia and is open Wednesdays from 1 - 5 p.m. and Saturdays from 11 a.m. - 4 p.m. Come learn how to repair bikes for the program - no experience necessary!
