

Rider Alert: Tacoma Dome Station Parking Renovation



This month, parking renovations begin at Tacoma Dome Station closing 200 parking stalls on a rotating basis.

Pierce Transit estimates the parking improvements will take a year to complete.

Since Tacoma Dome Station is a popular parking location, you may have a difficult time

finding an empty stall.

Consider these parking options:

- Find an alternative to driving your vehicle to Tacoma Dome Station, such as riding the bus.
- Ask a friend to drop you off.
- Meet your vanpool or carpool at another location.
- If possible, shift your schedule to arrive earlier in the morning.

Renovations will include improved lighting, signage, repairs to concrete, paint, and general clean-up of the transit hub.

Bus Riding 101: Travel Training Tips



Did you know we have a Travel Training program that provides free, one-onone or small-group training to anyone who wants to learn to use our bus system?

Here are a few helpful tips to remember when you're learning to ride the bus.

- Remember to bring exact change (cash or coins) for your bus fare. Our drivers can't make change or access the fare box if you over pay.
- Ticket booklets of 10 are available for purchase at Customer Service, Ralph's Thriftway (weekdays only), Lacey City Hall and all Timberland Regional Library branches in Thurston County. With a ticket booklet you will never accidentally spend your return fare on a snack or coffee!

Bus Passes Sold at Thurston County Timberland Regional Library Branches



We've partnered with Timberland Regional Library (TRL) to make it even easier to buy bus passes! The partnership

provides increased access to bus passes and enhances your experience, making passes even more convenient.

Passes can be purchased starting on the 24th of each month for the following month. Bus passes are sold in:

- Olympia: Olympia Transit Center, City Hall, Ralph's Thriftway (weekdays only), The Evergreen State College Bookstore, and Timberland Regional Library (closed Sundays)
- Lacey: City Hall and Timberland Regional Library (closed Sundays)
- Tenino: Timberland Regional Library (closed Sundays and Mondays)
- Tumwater: City Hall and Timberland Regional Library (closed Sundays)
- Yelm: Tim's Pharmacy & Gifts and Timberland Regional Library (closed Sundays and Mondays)

Four of the five TRL branches in Thurston County are served by Intercity Transit bus routes. Tenino is served by Rural Transit, which connects with Intercity Transit bus service.
