- Route 603 & 605 southbound (to Olympia):
 Schedule changes were made to improve transfers at the Capitol Campus and provide better timing in Downtown Tacoma with other commuter services.
- Route 605 northbound (to Tacoma): Schedule changes were made to improve connections at Tacoma Dome Station and in downtown Tacoma.
- Route 612 southbound (to Olympia): Schedule changes were made early in the morning to improve transfers at the Capitol Campus. Additional changes were made to improve spacing in downtown Tacoma with other commuter services. Please note the timepoint at the Hawks Prairie Park & Ride will now be an estimated timepoint.
- Route 612 northbound (to Tacoma): Two timepoints were changed to improve operational efficiency.

Local Service: Olympia

• Route 94 to Yelm: The timepoint at Union and Eastside changed to Eastside and 12th Ave (across from Bloodworks Northwest).

Improvements Coming to Tumwater Square



The Tumwater
Square Station
Improvement Project
is a joint effort
between the City
of Tumwater and
Intercity Transit.

Beginning March 5, Intercity Transit's contractor, Rognlin's, Inc., will begin

construction on the Tumwater Square Station located along Cleveland Avenue and Emerson Street. Work will occur between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday–Friday. The project is anticipated to be completed in late April 2018 (weather permitting).

Improvements include wider sidewalks, crosswalks with rapid flashing lights, bulb-outs, new asphalt surface, bus stops, and benches.

Cleveland Avenue and Emerson Street will be open for traffic during construction. Motorists are strongly encouraged to use alternate routes when possible to avoid the construction area. Access to businesses will remain open throughout the project.
