## September Service Update: Effective September 24, 2017



### Local Service

#### Olympia:

##### Route 41 to Evergreen:

Trips run on college class days from September 25, 2017 through June 8, 2018. The 15 minute trips do not operate on the following dates due to holidays, quarter breaks or evaluation weeks.

- 2017: November 20-24; December 11-31

- 2018: January 1-5, 15; February 19; March 19-30; May 28

Nightline (Route 41): Late-night service runs only on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday nights September 22, 2017 - June 17, 2018. Please see page 53 of the Transit Guide for non-service dates.

#### Tumwater:

Route 12: Weekday trips will leave the Olympia Transit Center five minutes later at :05 and :35. See page 21 of the Transit Guide for the full schedule.

Route 13: Weekday trips will leave the Olympia Transit Center five minutes earlier to improve on-time performance and transfer connections. See page 25 of the Transit Guide for the full schedule.

Routes 43 and 68: Leaves Tumwater Square one minute earlier to improve transfer connections.

#### Express:

- First three southbound trips will be leaving the Hawks Prairie Park and Ride five minutes earlier, arriving at the Olympia Transit Center five minutes earlier.
- Afternoon trips north and southbound have estimated times. Arrival times may vary depending on traffic conditions.
- Northbound trips are now using Zone G at Tacoma Dome Station.

### Nightline Weekend Service

Nightline, the weekend late-night shuttle between downtown Olympia and The Evergreen State College resumes September 22. Nightline operates Friday and Saturday nights until 3:30 a.m. and on Sundays until midnight.

The Evergreen State College contracts with Intercity Transit to provide this service. The service is open to the public and serves all stops along the route. Regular fares apply.
